He wishes to become the strongest fighter in his family, as well as the world. His older brother (Busteroni) is his greatest rival. Puncher Supreme has decided to join Angel on their journey to help get into bigger fights with bigger villains, and become much stronger. | Second Character - Joins Angel Goode to defeat a small villain before realizing that his own dreams can come true if he stays with Angel. |
| Doctor Purrfection (Real Name: Cattherine The Third) | The Evilest Crew | Sensible, Irritable, Smart, Know-It-All | Mad Scientists, Biology, Brain-Washing, Cat-Control | The greatest evil mind that you can find... but constrained to the body of a cute furball. Doctor Purrfection desires for utter world domination with cats, cats, and even more cats! Their handler and the owner to raise them escorts them everywhere, and is the only human who the Doctor enjoys the presence of. Although, with enough treats and praises, perhaps the Evilest Crew can also win the Doctor's heart over. | Angel tries to defeat Doctor Purrfection and her evil cult members, and almost succeeds in making Doctor Purrfection retire before deciding that it would be better to work together, since Doctor Purrfection and her Handler are incredibly purr-suasive and use their incredible work and fight as a resume to join the Evilest Crew. |
| Showrunner (Real Name: Carmen Maria Watts) | The Evilest Crew | Bubbly, Free Spirited (does not care about other people's opinions), Excitable, Enthusiastic, Chaotic | Acrobatic, Dancer, Performer, Hype-man, Aggressive Defense/Support | Dropped (Flunked) out of the Superhero Program, although she gave it her all. Afer watching Angel Goode's deeds spread across the news and keeping up with their story, she has become Angel Goode's #1 fan, and hopes to help support them with all of their 'evil' dees to make the world a (better) evil-er one. Her family, full to the brim of Superheroes, does not agree with her decision in the slightest, but that's certainly something that has never stopped her. | Deciding to follow her heart, Carmen throws away their dead Superhero Name "Bright Beam" and becomes a Supervillain instead "Showrunner". She makes a grand entrance and offers her praises, support, and undying loyalty to Angel Goode. After witnessing this, Angel decides to recruit her after all and welcomes her into their Evilest Crew. Needless to say, Showrunner's family is not happy. |
| The Handler (Real Name: Sprinkles) | Doctor Purrfection | Formal, Polite, Quiet | Pats and Cuddles, Pet Grooming, Cleaning, Agility, Spray Bottle | Once a normal and average cat owner, the Handler realized that one of their foster kittens had incredible intelligence that had never been seen before. They decided to quit their job to help Doctor Purrfection in her purr-suit of utter world domination, since nothing makes them happier as a cat owner than seeing their cats enjoying themselves. | Since Doctor Purrfection is unable to actually talk, The Handler works as both their escort as well as a translator. A lot of people do not actually believe the translations, but the Handler doesn't care. They help translate for the Doctor throughout the game quite often. |
| The Mime (temp) | Themselves | Silly, Sadistic, Goober | Invisible Walls and Ropes, Performer, Comedian | Silent, deadly, and silly as can be, the Mime is a petty criminal who enjoys luring in naive and gullible victims with performances before snatching their wallets away for good. There' no record of what may have been the reason for their dive into crime, but they seem to really enjoy their job. | not yet determined which area the mime will be |
| Malfred the Butler | The Evilest Crew (actually with the Mayor) | Old-Fashioned, Respectful, Calm | Impeccable Service, Silverware Polishing, Shoe Shining, Speed, Timeliness | Trained to be a perfect butler by the Supervillain League, the Mayor sent Malfred to keep a close eye on Angel Goode, who seems to be a possible threat. | Given as a gift from the Supervillain League to the up and coming villain Angel Goode, Malfred is very polite and quiet, acting as a 'Savepoint' no matter where Angel is going or has been. |
| Slimeantha | The Sewer Protection Squad | Light-hearted, Protective, Sharp-witted | Division/Multiplication of Self, Hivemind, Swimming, Clairvoyance (ish) | Part of the Sewer Protection Squad, Slimeantha protects the area closest to a powerplant primarily located underneath the city. The Sewer Protection Squad believes that any and all visitors to the sewers besides their own members are up to no good and wish to put people at harm. As a result, Slimeantha will not allow even normal workers through the area, earning her reputation as a Supervillain. | As Angel and the Evilest Crew descend down into the sewer depths to access the power plant, Slimeantha stands in their way. |
| Captain Cactus (Real Name: Henry Henrison) | Themselves | Dramatic, Determined, Desperate | Cactus Gun of Pointiness, Mini-Cacti Minions, Science, Cacti Converter | Raised by his single father, Captain Cactus was neglected for most of his childhood. His father was obsessed with his work, primarily involving desert plantlife such as cacti. In a desperate attempt in winning over his father's love, Henry Henrison made a device to try and become a small potted cactus. This machine failed him, however, and caused him to become a half-man half-cactus abomination. Nowadays, he works tirelessly to try to convert the entire world into a desert and cacti plants, hoping that his father will finally be pleased with him. | As The Evilest Crew (or what has formed of it) reaches the City Park, they find it covered with sand and cacti. Angel meets their first (big) supervillain, and works to defeat Captain Cactus, forcing him to retire for good. |

| Sea-Gal | Superhero Program | Tired, Responsible, Introverted | Flight, Sharp Vision, Food Stealing | Graduated from the first ever batch of Superheroes in the Superhero Program, Sea-Gal is a very tired and hard worker. She usually keeps an eye over the harbor and docks. Since she's not as popular as other Superheroes, there are many people who do not recognize her. She avoids awkward situations and unwelcome stares by staying in the skies for many hours at a time, only coming down when she's too exhausted to continue. | Before/After (not yet decided) the Evilest Crew goes to confront Doctor Purrfection and their menacing cat-cult, they are faced with a coincidental meeting against Sea-Gal, who recognizes them. She decides to try and arrest them, then and there, causing a hiccup to Angel's plans. |
| Styxie Trixie Delixie | Themselves | Gleeful, Passionate, Loud, Audacious | Sharp Claws and Fangs, Venom, Gadgets | Originally known as one of the brightest students of her generation in the field of technology, Styxie's family's assets were destroyed by an unexpected storm one day. She temporarily became an underground vigilante in hopes of being able to earn enough money to fix all of the damages, and used her expertise and skills she had learned already. During this time, the Supervillain League contacted her and offered an even larger sum of money for her to join full-time. Styxie's love of rebellion in society had only grown since she started, and she easily accepted the job to become a villain rather than a vigilante. | Sneaking into the underground powerplant, Styxie has decided to suck up all of the energy she can out of it as the first part of her evil devious plants, causing internet, electricity, water, and phonelines to go down before the second part of her plans (attacking the helpless civilians) goes through. |
| Newsflash | The News & Superhero Program | Extroverted, Enthusiastic, Self-Centered | Speed, Camera-Head, Loud Announcer Voice, Photographic Memory | Although his head is a camera, few know this Superhero's backstory, and only that he delivers the news in a consistent, timely, and enthusiastic fashion. He was born with a camera as his head as part of a Superhero experiment. He's loved by the general public for his optimistic opinions and efficiency. Over time, Newsflash has become more associated with the News Networks rather than the Superhero Program. The Mayor has to go out of his way to reminds Newsflash how and why he allowed him to become a reporter on occasion, and 'sets him back on the right track'. | Is a famous newscaster, constantly keeping everybody within the city (including Angel Goode and the Evilest Crew) updated on recent/current events. At some point, he goes from being on a screen to actually reporting on Angel Goode's activities live and in person. |
| Mastermind | Law Enforcement & Superhero Program | Workaholic, Tired Single Dad, Strict | Clairvoyance, Strategy, Lots of Minions | In charge of leading the law enforcement of the city, Mastermind spends countless hours and days focusing on where and which ongoing crimes are the most dangerous in order to know where to allocate the city's resources and time. Since the Superheroes from the Superhero Program can only be in so many places at once, he has to ensure that the normal power-less humans working under him are not spread too thin at all times. Angel Goode and the Evilest Crew ends up just being another big headache for him to deal with, and he does his best to stomp out Angel's influence as soon as possible. | Given the responsibility of handling the city's law enforcement task force, he consistently gains new grey hairs (not that anybody can see) underneath his mask and disguise, tired of the nonsense that the Evilest Crew and other Supervillains from the Supervillain League are putting his enforcers through. |
| Manager Andy (Real Name: Andrew Larrison) | Fast Food Restaurant & Clothing Store | Power-Hungry, Narcissistic, Mean, Uncooperative | Yelling, Abusing His Power, Throwing Tantrums | Andrew Larrison has never been a fortunate man, although one could say that all his misfortunes were in fact self-inflicted. He was once a popular jock in his own high school days, and has never been able to move on from his past popularity. No matter what happens, Andy seems to always find a way to blame things on others, ruling over the establishments he works at using fear. His workers all hate him so much, that if he one day happened to be attacked by a medium-sized teenager and a massive hulking wrestler, they'd only protect him if they get a raise. | The first 'villain' that Angel encounters since they've never actually witnessed a bad manager before in the past, being sheltered from such atrocities by their parents in the past. After Andy gets his butt kicked by Angel and Puncher Supreme, he moves to a small clothing store to work there, holding a grudge for when they inevitably meet again. |
| Bully Jake | Themselves | Insecure, Aggressive, Moody, Violent | Punching, Crying for Mommy, Kicking | The bully of the suburbs where Angel lives is infamous for his tyranny over the streets. His name? Jake. Bully Jake. Bully Jake might come from a somewhat normal family with money, but he'll still want to take your lunch money with him. | The first opponent that Angel decides to take on after they donned their new Supervillain apparel. After Angel kicks their ass, Bully Jake is never seen again, likely moving to live in a part of the city where others do not know of his humiliation. |
